Amendment to

Regional Transportation Plan

The Greater Madison MPO (formally named Madison Area Transportation Planning Board) will conduct a public hearing on an amendment to the [Regional Transportation Plan 2050](#). The Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) guides investments in and strategies to implement to improve the multi-modal transportation system.

The hearing invites comments or concerns regarding the amendment, which would add the U.S. Highway (USH) 51 (McFarland to Stoughton) reconstruction project to the official, fiscally constrained plan as explained in this [memo](#). The RTP 2050 had recommended completion of the USH 51 corridor study and anticipated amendment of the plan to add the recommended project once the scope and design details were finalized, Majors program funding secured, and regional agreement on the project reached. The study has been completed, the project scope finalized, and Majors program funding was recently approved. For more information on the USH 51 project, see the [project webpage](#). The estimated cost of the USH 51 project is \$174 million (\$203 million in year-of-expenditure dollars).
